Weather

Playgroup Binder

Snack

Snacks should feed approximately an average of 45 people and cost between \$40-\$60. Please see our sheet in the "Playgroup binder" for examples of healthy snack choices to bring.

Crafts

Crafts should be simple and require minimal parental intervention. LPG has a variety of craft supplies. Please see the sheet in the "Playgroup Binder" for a list of our supplies and craft ideas. Should you need to purchase supplies for your craft please see a board member for approval then submit your receipt for reimbursement.

Lakedell Playgroup Membership Options

First visit is free! Come check it out before you join.

Casual Member (maximum of 5 visits)

- \$10 per family per visit (\$5 from first visit purchases your Lakedell Ag membership)
- \$15 *per child* for fieldtrips or parties

Full Year Member

- \$65 per family per visit (\$5 purchases your Lakedell Ag membership)
 Register prior to September 15, 2013 and your fee will only be \$45
- 2 Fundraiser Event
- 1 Playground clean up
- 2 snacks
- 1 craft
- 1 toy clean
- Upon purchasing your membership you will pick the dates you wish to bring snack. We understand that unforeseen things may come up you may contact a board member to change your date or find another member to either trade dates with.
- 4 Deposit Cheques of \$100

Deposits: <u>UNDATED DEPOSIT CHEQUES OF \$100</u>. These cheques will **ONLY** be cashed in the event that a member neglects to fulfill any of there membership commitments (eg. Snack, fundraiser, etc)

Where does your Money go?

As playgroup is ran on a totally volunteer basis any money made through membership fees and fundraisers goes directly back into playgroup to purchase new toys, safety equipment, craft supplies, some educational outings, party supplies, marketing supplies and maintenance supplies. At each of the 3 meetings playgroup holds members are encouraged to join so they may understand and help enhance our playgroup!
